WATERFORD UTILITY BILLING

The City of Waterford bills for sewer and water services, as well as water consumption, each month. The monthly fees are due by the last day of each month.

For new residents moving into a home, there is a one time sewer deposit fee of \$80.00, a water deposit fee of \$120.00, and a non-refundable account set-up fee of \$25.00. You may submit a written request, after two years of good payment history to have your deposit refunded.

NEW WATER RATES

On November 17, 2016, the Waterford City Council approved new water rates to be implemented over the next five (5) years. Each increase will be effective on July 1st of every year beginning on July 1, 2017 until the final increase on July 1, 2021.

The City's charge to hook up to the sewer line is \$3,894.40.

GARBAGE SERVICE INFO

Gilton Solid Waste bills for this service. The billing rate allows for each residence to have 2 cans which can be used to hold household garbage and yard waste. Garbage pick up days for Waterford are Tuesday through Friday (depending on the area of town). Cans should be placed with wheels against the curb at least 15 feet from any parked vehicle and 5 feet from each other. Lids must be closed for appropriate dumping. To assure proper service, put can(s) out the night before your scheduled garbage day. Remove all cans from curb within 24 hours after pickup.

Gilton Solid Waste also provides 2 bulky item pickups per calendar year. Scheduled by appointments only, please contact (209) 527-3781 for pickup.

The City of Waterford provides a Christmas Tree Pick-up during the month of January. Christmas trees need to be placed on the curb in front of your residence.
