AMENDMENT NO.1 To the Agreement between the CITY OF WATERFORD And GILTON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT, INC For FRANCHISE AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1, dated January 6, 2022, is entered into by and between the **CITY OF WATERFORD**, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "CITY") and Gilton Solid Waste Management, Inc, (hereinafter "COLLECTOR").

WHEREAS, the parties hereto previously entered into an agreement dated September 7, 2017, whereby COLLECTOR will perform Solid Waste Collection services for the City (hereinafter the "Agreement").

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree to amend said Agreement as follows:

1. Section 6. of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

TERM OF AGREEMENT: The term of this Agreement shall commence on February 1, 2022 ("Effective Date") and shall be in force for five (5) calendar years. On the third anniversary and each following anniversary of the Effective Date, the term will automatically be extended one (1) additional year, until such time as either the City or the Collector submits in writing to the other that their intent is to terminate said Agreement. If such notice is provided, the Agreement shall be terminated two (2) year from the next Effective Date anniversary, notwithstanding the remaining term that would otherwise be in effect, and the City may in its discretion advertise for competitive bids for solid waste collection services with such services to commence after the expiration of the contract term of this Agreement. Nothing herein shall be deemed or construed to impair the right of the City to immediately terminate the Agreement with Collector due to Collector's substantial failure to perform the services and responsibilities specified and agreed to in this Agreement.

2. Section 8.1. of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

RATES: The maximum rates to be charged by Collector are set forth in Exhibit C ("Rate" or "Rates") and may be adjusted by the City Council by ordinance or resolution. For the first year of the Agreement, Collector shall charge rates that are no greater than the maximum rates as provided in Exhibit C. In years two (2) through five (5) of the Agreement Term, the City will adjust the maximum charges made to Customers under this Agreement to reflect annual changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers ("CPI") published by the U.S. Department of Labor for the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose, CA statistical area. Such adjustments shall not exceed two and a half percent (2.5%) per year. The adjustment shall become effective on the anniversary of the Effective Date and be based on the previous twelve-month index analysis from September to August. In all subsequent years, the Collector may request,

COLLECTOR

and the City Council shall consider, rate adjustments based on the above referenced CPI index, in addition to any other adjustments provided for under subsections 8.3. and 8.4.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
